Mandatory Items:

Model "A" type four cylinder engine

Model "A" type front axle, rear axle and suspension

Model "A" type frame (chassis)

Model "A" production type body or custom period style commercial or sports type body and fenders. Body must not be modified, chopped, channeled, sectioned or altered

MAFCV also accepts original Ford vehicles manufactured up to 1948 that have mandatory items appropriate to the original year of manufacture

Roadworthy, Safety and Modifications:

VicRoads Roadworthy Certificate: All vehicles must have a current RWC when first presented to MAFCV for acceptance

All owners must ensure that their vehicles are in a roadworthy condition whenever operated on the roads or in public places

All owners must immediately provide RWC inspection certificate to the MAFCV Officer when modifications have been fitted that require it.
